IBERIA PARK is packed with family fun, with exciting attractions and amazing shows. There is no charge to enter the park and once you are inside "you make up your own experience". Don't miss the "Redbeard's Return" (El Regreso de Barbarroja), adventure show with the Mediterranean's most terrifying pirates! And if that's not enough, explore the world of illusion with the Magic Experience, a thrilling magic show. Open during the summer season. www.terramiticapark.com

TERRA MITICA. Reveal the hidden secrets of the Mediterranean, Egypt, Greece and Rome. Thousands of years of history transformed into thrills, excitement and adrenaline. Grown-ups can speed face down at 100 kilometres an hour, plummet into the abyss, loop the loop and ride the corkscrews on Europe's longest roller coaster. If you enjoy shows, **Benidorm Circus**, open during the summer season, is a traditional circus without animals, with 'Cirque du Soleil' style acts such as tightrope walkers, acrobats, jugglers, conjurers and comedians. Open from May to October. www.benidormcircus.es

If you are a family of nature lovers, don't miss the Serra Gelada Natural Park, just 3 km from the town centre. There are walking paths of different levels that will lead you to the summit, or why not visit the Cross (la Cruz) or cycle to Punta Cavall to marvel at breath-taking views and wonderful plant life.

Benidorm is also a destination for family adventures: **4x4 trips, paintball, go-karts, mini-golf, cycling and sustainable vehicles such as segways and electric bicycles.**

Benidorm has tourist buses that transport visitors around Benidorm and its surroundings and on to Guadalest and Algar. The buses have audio systems with commentaries in five languages: Spanish, English, French, German and Russian. There are cards for 24 hours, 72 hours and seven days.

When it comes to accommodation, Benidorm never fails to impress. If you enjoy staying in hotels, there are more than 125 one to five-star hotels in Benidorm. Many hotels lay on shows for children and have just areas for them, with childcare teams and entertainers who look after them and entertain them during the holidays. If you would rather camp, there are more than ten campsites in Benidorm, most of them with entertainment programmes for children. All of them are equipped for families, with swimming pools and green areas. If your family likes staying in apartments then this is the place for you, because there are more than 6,000 in Benidorm.

Benidorm is a safe, fun holiday destination, ideal for families. With endless leisure activities, it's the perfect place for children of all ages, whatever their interests. You'll all have a terrific time in Benidorm. We'll provide the sun and sea. Just bring your excitement and enthusiasm.

A marvellous microclimate with warm, year-round temperatures and very low rainfall make Benidorm the ideal choice for a family holiday.

It has long sandy beaches lapped by crystal-clear, calm, shallow waters where children can play and splash while mum and dad sit back on the sand and enjoy the Mediterranean. Accessed via walkways, Benidorm's beaches have handy meeting points, landmarks with memorable shapes such as planes, balls and trains placed high enough to be seen from a distance that kids can remember easily if they lose sight of their parents.

Floating platforms in the sea with slides and blow-up attractions are a huge attraction for kids in summertime. Anchored 150 metres from the shore, safety is assured with special markings and lifeguards keeping watch on the platform and on the sand.

There are two lending libraries on Benidorm's beaches, one on the Levante beach (open all year round except February) and another alongside the port (from June to October), with areas for adults, children and youngsters.



Benidorm has facilities for all types of family-friendly watersports: kayak, parasailing, water skiing, pedal boats, snorkelling (in coves and around Benidorm island), and much more. There's a scuba diving school, where try-out dives are available for children from the age of ten as well as new Sea Trek for the over-eights.

If you want to rest, visit Benidorm Island and enjoy a pleasant boat trip along the Poniente and Levante beaches. When you reach the island, jump aboard the submarine with glass walls and look at the marvellous underwater animals and plants, or explore the paths to see its plant and animal life.
